CORRECTIONS & ADDITIONS

Youth Entries: The prospectus and the printed version of Bulletin #1 omitted to state that exhibits from young philatelists will be assigned to one of **three age group categories: A: 13 - 15, B: 16 - 18, C: 19 - 21 years. Full details and rules are available from the State Commissioner, the Secretary or swanriverstampshow.com**

Credit Card facilities: As mentioned in Bulletin 1, the high cost of bank fees means the Swan River Stamp Show will not be able to absorb the bank charges. Rather than charge for the facility and instigate a fee, the committee has decided to accept a minimum transaction amount of \$25 on Visa, Bankcard and Mastercard credit cards. This was implemented from 1st June.

Alternative methods of payment are acceptable: cheques and Australian money orders must be made out to the Western Australian Philatelic Council, or (Australian) funds may be transferred directly by Electronic Funds Transfer.

Due to circumstance beyond our control, the special supporter sheetlet in the membership packs will not be overprinted. Instead, it will have a special supporters tab. Full details of the Supporters Pack and souvenirs are on page 2.

INVITED DISPLAYS FOR FREMANTLE

There will be two Invited Displays of 'Western Australia' at Swan River Stamp Show, one Colonial and one State. The latter will be 'Air Mail in Western Australia: the Air Mail Fee Period 1921-1959' by Brian Pope, APR. The carriage of mail by air in Australia under contract was inaugurated in December 1921 between Geraldton and Derby. From that time until 1 October 1959, every item required prepayment of an Air Mail Fee of 3d per 1/2 oz in addition to normal postage.

This exhibit includes air mail rates, and the routes flown, both within Australia and overseas. The means by which the contract load was increased on the East-West route in June 1929 are explained for the first time and there is a section on the impact of WW 2, including scarce POW airmail.
